



2003 Tsunami Rally August 23/24, 2003 Round 4 of the Yokohama Tire BC Rally Championship

The Rally

This event is # 4 in the Yokohama Tire BC Championship. This paved TSD rally adventure spans one evening and early morning hours on choice public roads on Vancouver Island. Organized by the Island Rallysport Club and sanctioned by Rally Pacific Motorsports under CARS General Competition Rules.

The Route

Consists of 100% paved roads. The route begins in Langford, just outside Victoria and ends in Nanaimo, covering approximately 400 km, with no more than 200 km between gas stops.

The Scoring

There will be the required one-second grace at each control, one point per second early or late, max of 300 at any one control, and maximum accumulated penalty of 600 per regularity, as per http://www.rallybc.com/html/regional_rules.htm#Timing

Required Safety Equipment:

As per BC Rally Regulations, at <u>http://www.rallybc.com/html/regional_rules.htm#Safety</u> Note specifically: 1 reflective self-supporting warning emergency triangle (12" sides minimum), basic first aid kit, and minimum 5BC fire extinguisher. Open cars require a roll bar. It is probably a good idea if you bring a **full sized spare**, not a donut.

The Rules

The rally will be broken up into a series of transits (non-timed) sections and regularities (timed sections), with a number of these forming a leg, each of which ends with a meal/gas break. The rally runs on straightforward instructions, which are provided in both kilometers and miles, but official measurements and calculations are based on the Km figures.

Minors

Any entrants who are under the age of majority must sign an additional waiver, as well as have their legal guardian sign a special waiver. Any interested minors \underline{MUST} contact Christa at z31@shaw.ca or (250) 882-0862 for those forms and more details.

The Awards

Directions to registration at Boston Pizza from Schwartz Bay Terminal:
